Isaac Jogues, Rene Goupil, and Jean Lalande — died trying to bring the Gospel and the Eucharistic Lord — to the Mohawks of the region, and where, a decade after their martyrdoms, St. Kateri Tekakwitha, one of the greatest witnesses to Eucharistic Adoration, was born."
