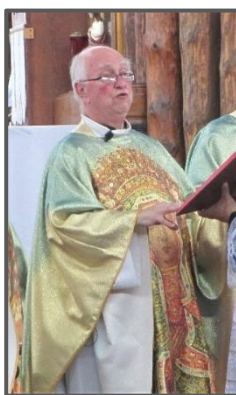

22 Masses for 2100 Youths!

Neocatechuminal Way pilgrimages filled the week of July 19 with Masses, processions, prayer, music, catechesis, and testimonials. Originating in CA, CO, OR, AZ, NM, TX, WY, MO, GA, and NJ, they stopped at shrines en route to a youth gathering at Gettysburg. In the spirit of the North American Martyrs, they were filled with evangelical zeal.

Approved by Rome, St John Paul II described the NCW as “an itinerary of Catholic formation. . . and an instrument for the New Evangelization.” Formed in Spain in 1964 to bring the Gospel to marginalized areas of cities and counties, it is now in 134 countries, has over 21,000 communities, and 125 Redemptorist Mater Seminaries.
