August 15 The Feast of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, Body and Soul, into Heaven.

This year marks the 138th Anniversary of the Auriesville Shrine. St. Isaac Jogues and St. Rene Goupil came here as captives on August 14, the Vigil of the Feast Day, in 1642. Having purchased this holy ground in 1884, the Jesuits celebrated the first Mass in the small domed chapel on August 15, 1885.

The Shrine now has a novena specific to the devotion of the Shrine and of the Auriesville Saints to the Blessed Mother. It is available on our website and Facebook page. Please join us in these prayers and in a Novena of Masses. All but two days are so far covered by visiting priests, special events, and by our regularly scheduled Sunday Mass.

Couture Remembered

Guillaume Couture, Jesuit donné, was tortured alongside St. Isaace Jogues in 1642. He was a loyal friend to Father Jogues who remained in contact with him throughout their captivity in the Mohawk Valley. Couture gained his freedom. Paul Couture of Montreal was appreciative that his ancestor is commemorated on Shrine grounds and in museum.
