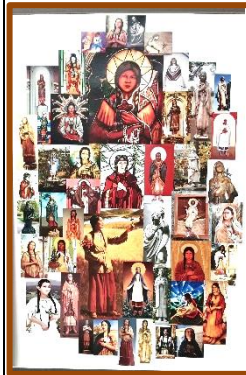

We know that without the blood sacrifice of the North American Martyrs, we would not have St. Kateri. Hear how the Martyrs have spiritually impacted the lives of Shrine's 2022 visiting priest, Fr Giorgio, and Pilgrimage/Museum Manager Beth Lynch.

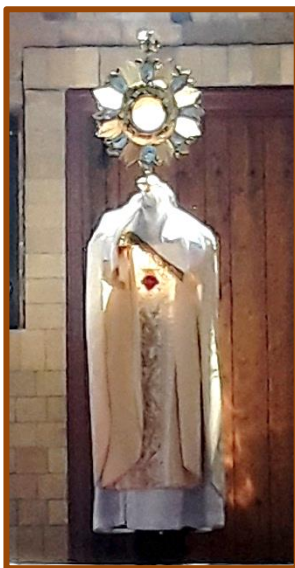

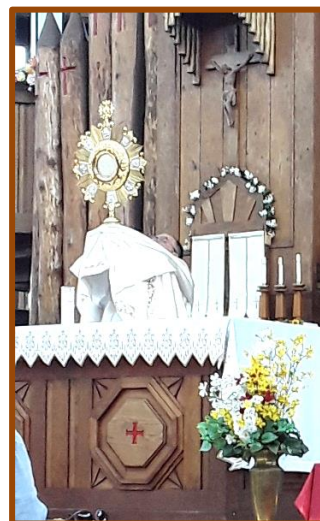


Fr Giorgio (left) led a procession in the Coliseum after **Corpus Christi Mass**.
