## 40 HOUR DEVOTION

Friday June 24 - Sunday June 26

The Forty Hours Devotion of Eucharistic Adoration originated in Italy in the 16<sup>th</sup> Century and was primarily established in the U.S. by St. John Neumann, Bishop of Philadelphia, during anti-Catholic persecution in the mid-1800s.

Today there is a resurgence of anti-Catholic bias in the culture, and a tragic decline within the Church of belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. With this 40 Hour Devotion, the faithful can make reparation for sins and participate in solemn Adoration and prayer.

This is the second year that John Leaps Evangelization is bringing the event to the Shrine. From Friday evening through Sunday afternoon, there will be Adoration, Benediction, Holy Mass, Confession, and presentations by Catholic speakers.

Clergy participating this year include Bishop Edward Scharfenberger, Albany Diocese; Bishop Peter Byrne, Auxiliary Bishop of NY; Father Justin Cinnante, O' Carm, Torchbearers of America; Father Jeffery Pomeisl to speak on "The Holy Family and the Restoration of Families;" Father Thomas Celso to speak on "The Voice of Our Lady of America to Sister Mary Ephrem.

Presentation schedule and speaker bio will follow. Names and topic are: Craig Turner, Catholic Speaker and Author: "Hidden Realities and Divine Manifestations: The Bread from Heaven;" Beth Lynch, Saints of Auriesville Museum, Auriesville Shrine: "Who Would Be a Priest to Them Should I Flee?" Phyllis Murphy, Conference Speaker: "Forgiveness –The Way to Healing;" John Murphy, Conference Speaker: "The Importance of Prayer."

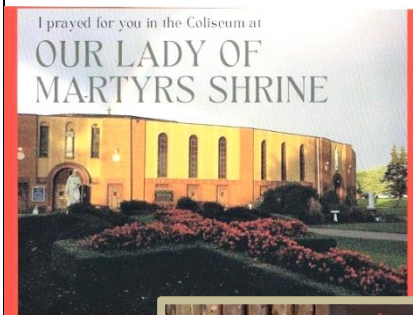
## 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Blessings, Father Giorgio!
